The next phase of approximately 9-weeks* is an on the job introduction to the renovation trades. Youth work with skilled tradespeople trained in anxiety management to develop an understanding of the renovation and horticulture trades, including basic mathematical skills, business communication, time management, customer service, and workplace safety.

Successful participants will end their time with new understanding and skills - job-ready to gain employment.
